Invitations to the main performance were extended to junior high school students from the neighboring cities of Sanyo Onoda and Mine in addition to Ube City. UBE hopes to provide more children with opportunities to experience classical music and to support their growth through music education. UBE also sees this effort as a contribution to SDG 4, "Quality Education."
